4. Uniforms are kept in stock at Bousfield.

- Nursery and Pre-Primary Class : Aqua leotard, skirt and pink Crossover (Pack £32), pink socks and ballet shoes to be bought from specialist shops.
- Primary to Senior: Turquoise leotard, skirt and headband (Pack £27), pink socks or tights and ballet shoes To be bought from specialist shops.

All items must be labelled with your child's name.

Hair should be tied back neatly, in a ponytail and a bun is preferred from Grade 2.

BOUSFIELD SCHOOL. DANCING CLASSES. REMINDER TO ALL PARENTS

La Sylvaine offers ballet classes at Bousfield School both for pupils of the school and for pupils from other schools. The classes are given on the premises and certain conditions are imposed on as which have to be strictly adhered to. **All the pupils of La Sylvaine and their parents are required to follow the regulations set out in this letter.**

- **PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITY**

Between 3.30 and 4pm

All children are directly under the responsibility and the supervision of their parents.

At the end of each class, all children are **under the responsibility of their parents, not ours**. Children must be collected promptly and must leave the building as soon as possible.

- **LEAVING THE SCHOOL PREMISES**

Please make absolutely sure that your children do not run around in the school or on the playground. For security reasons, no one attending the classes or their parents is allowed to remain within the school precincts once the classes are finished. It should be made clear that we are only permitted to use **the two halls and changing rooms allocated to us and no other part of the school building except for the purpose of access**.

Noise must be kept to a minimum so as not to disrupt other classes or teachers working in the classrooms.

- **WALKING THROUGH THE HALL**

Please, **do not walk or sit in the hall when a class is being taught, unless specifically invited to do so**.

It disturbs children and teachers and interrupts the rhythm of a class.

- **NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL**

Once registered, pupils are automatically assumed to be continuing their classes from term to term. Notice of withdrawal of a child must be given in writing at least 5 weeks before the end of the term or the **fees of the following term are payable IN FULL**.

- **CARS**

Kindly note that the school playground cannot be used as a car park even after school hours. It is strictly out of bounds.

It is most important that you help us respect our arrangements with the school so as to avoid problems or tension with Bousfield School. We are eager to keep a good relationship and we will exclude all those who are unable to comply with these requirements.
