3. Uniforms: Uniforms are kept in stock at Chelsea Theatre but parents are requested to buy shoes and tights from Dance Attic, North End Road, or Freed's, 94 St Martin's Lane. An elastic must be sewn across the instep of the ballet shoe, half way between the vamp and the heel. Please look at the photo on the website.

- Grade 4 and 5: RAD regulation leotard with straps, navy crossover
- Grade 6 and 7: RAD regulation leotard and skirt (Raspberry)
- Modern Hip/Hop: pupils should wear a leotard (Turquoise up to Grade 5 but any colour or style for older pupils), black Jazz trousers, Ballet or Jazz shoes for the Warm up section of the class. Sneakers may be used during the Hip Hop class but should be kept specifically for the dance class and should not be used outdoors.

All items must be labelled with your child's name.

Hair should be tied back neatly, in a ponytail and a bun is preferred from Grade 1.
